Call to Order: President Jerry Craig called the meeting to order at 11:01 AM with 12 members in attendance, including Vice President Durbin Seidel, Treasurer Jim Ferry, and Secretary David Dust.

Minutes: The minutes of the May meeting were approved unanimously.

Treasurer's Report: Treasurer Ferry reported the club's current checkbook balance is \$3223.44 and the savings balance is \$10,644.47. The treasurer's report was approved unanimously.

Safety Officer's Report: On behalf of Safety Officer Wilson, President Craig kept it short and said that the Safety Officer had "no comment".

Old Business: Secretary Dust thanked Carl Anderson and Jim Foerster for helping remove the old south taxi-way, as was approved by the motion at the May meeting.
